West Bound H1 Take Exit 10, Pearl City/Waimalu exit, merge onto Moanalua rd. right on Hoomalu Rd and right onto Komomai drive and the park will be on you left

East Bound H1 Take Exit 10, Pearlridge, Waimalu exit, merge onto Moanalua Rd and make a left turn on to Kaahumanu St and the park will be on your left.

Parking is available on the upper end of the park as well as off Komomai drive.



USER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Violation of the following City and County of Honolulu park permit rules will result in the permit for future field practice and games being denied or modified.

1. **No** alcoholic beverages are to be consumed on park premises.
2. **No** driving or parking on grass of any type of motorized vehicles. (Carts, off road, etc).
3. **No double parking or parking in entrance or exit lanes.**
4. **No** sales of any kind. Permits, product liability insurance and Department of Health clearance required.

FIELD MAINTENANCE:

The City and County of Honolulu park permit requires the following:

1. Users are responsible to check the field for any unsafe conditions that may cause harm to participants. If any unsafe conditions exist, it is the responsibility of the field user to either correct the unsafe condition before play begins or to cancel play and notify the field coordinator for corrective action.
2. Clean-up of litter created by players and spectators is the responsibility of the team using the field at the time of the practice or game. Failure may result in the league being charged a deposit fee or loss of the permit. (i.e., bottles, tape, umbrellas, slippers, food, band-aid, Kleenex, etc.)
3. **Practices or games should be cancelled if the field is muddy.**

ADDITIONAL RULES:

1. Remind your players not to kick the ball against the bathroom walls or the recreation center walls.
2. If you pot-luck after the game, please bring extra garbage bags. Use them if existing garbage cans are full.
3. In order to keep the park in good condition, please have your team participate in field maintenance day. This will usually consist of weeding to remove the sleeping grass, leveling low spots and planting grass, or repairing sprinkler heads. Since the kids are the users of the field, they should learn that they need to give back to the community. So get your kids to participate.
